The Endowment Memorial Fund with Edward Jones has a balance of \$164,055.07. The NOW account and checking account at Friends and Family Credit Union has a combined account of \$12,201.85 as of June 30, 2023. Donations and Memorials totaled \$5,198.00 and \$5,674.28 was spent on items needed by the club. New pots and pans and rollers for the stove were purchased for the kitchen. A new computer was purchased for the club secretary and microphones were purchased for the two that were lost. Other small items were also purchased.

The Memorial Book will be retired and kept. A new book will be started for the 2023-2024 year. No response was received from our request for information about Delores O'Neal. She paid \$150.00 in June 2003 to have her name on the Memorial Board in the Music Room. We do not know if she is still with us. The Memorial Committee plans to place her name on the board next spring, unless we hear otherwise of her whereabouts.
